Achievements

1. In addition, The Jordan University of Science and Technology trained a psychiatrist to establish the first Child Psychiatric Clinic in the Northern part of Jordan. Moreover, I was chosen to lead the first Child Psychiatry clinic at The King Hussein Cancer Center in February 2022.
